- Contacts at process partners (e.g. address and role data)

6. Categories of recipients to whom the data may be disclosed:

- Public authorities on the basis of overriding law
- Internal departments and associated companies to fulfil the purposes referred to under No. 4

7. Standard periods for the erasure (deletion) of data:

The data is erased when it is no longer required for the business purpose referred to under No. 4 and is not subject to a statutory retention period.
